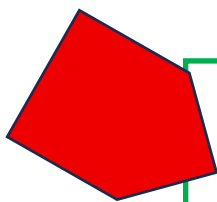
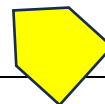

much appreciated by all of our Residents.

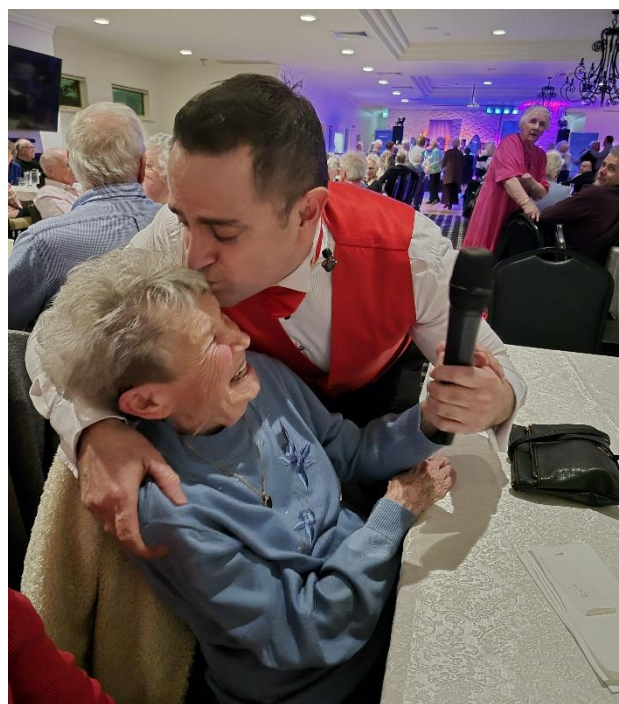
